The Land Down Under



During 1770 the east coast of Australia, was claimed for Great Britain under the name of New South Wales.

It was originally British penal colony consisting of convicts and prisoners.

Free settlers from Great Britain started to arrive in 1793.

Aboriginals were the original inhabitants of Australia. Aboriginal people today mostly speak English, with Aboriginal phrases and words being added to create Australian Aboriginal English.



Koala - emblem of Australia.

Some elements of Aboriginal languages have been incorporated into Australian English, mainly as names for flora and fauna for example: *dingo, kangaroo, koala boomerang, barbecue, bungalow.*

One of the best-known is *outback* which means a "remote, sparsely-populated"

Aussie — a slang for Australian .



Australia is now a British dominion. Dominion is a free country but chooses the queen as head of state.
